
The ICB4 is the international standard on competence for Project, Programme and Portfolio managers. The competence needed for each of these domains is defined in the following competence areas:

"Practice" of our work: needed for Projects, Programmes and Portfolios.

"Perspective" of the initiatives you're running: the context within which the initiative is run and the link to what needs to be achieved.

An insight into ICB 4 can revolutionise any poject professional's approach to Project Management.
